In the framework of the European Master's Degree Program “Distributed Systems Engineering”, **Telecommunication Systems Institute of National Technical University of Ukraine “KPI”** (NTUU “KPI”) and **Computer Science Department at the Dresden University of Technology (TUD)** offer single international program “*Distributed Systems Engineering*”.

Students of NTUU “KPI” have an opportunity to study for NTUU “KPI” Master's Degree Program “*Information and Telecommunication Networks*” in conjunction with TUD Master's Degree Program “*Computational Engineering*” for obtaining second higher education.

Forming and training of students starts with the second year of their education at NTUU “KPI” as a result of completing the first year of study.

Requirements for students

- NTUU “KPI” “*Bachelor of Telecommunications*” Diploma;
- Sub-department recommendation of undergoing Master’s program;
- Fluency in English;
- Basic proficiency in German;
- Participation in scientific research and research projects;
- Successfully passed entrance examination to the two-year Master's Degree Program “*Distributed Systems Engineering*”;
- Student selection will be conducted by joint commission of NTUU “KPI” and TUD.

Education

Master's Degree Program is conducted on a contractual basis: students at their own expense or through grants received by them. Depending on the success and activity in education and scientific research, students have an opportunity to receive scholarships as financial support for participation in the program. The number of scholarships is limited.

Term of study - 2 years. Students study at NTUU “KPI” for the first year and at TUD for the second year.

The student has two scientific advisors from

NTUU “KPI” and TUD. Defence of Master's thesis takes place either at NTUU “KPI”, or at TUD.

At each of the partner universities, students undergo education according to local educational and examination regulations.

Students are responsible for obtaining insurance and must present it during admission to the partner university. The joint commission sets the rules regarding funding students participating in the program. These rules will be adopted in accordance with local legal restrictions of each partner universities.

Defence of Master's thesis

Depending on the success in education and achievements in scientific research during the educational period, students on its completion get:

- **TU Dresden Master's degree “Master of Science”** or a **certificate** of study additional disciplines and training in Germany (depending on the success in education and achievements in scientific research at the partner universities);
- and **NTUU “KPI” Master's degree “Master in Telecommunications”**.
